

## Short-Term Mission Team Fees\*



**Team Registration Fee:** Due when you register your team

**\$300 per team**

This non-refundable fee registers your team with us and guarantees your requested dates. This “earnest money” assures us that you are truly planning to come and are preparing for a trip. The last thing we want to do is accept a team who’s wavering in their decision to come and have to turn down a team that is truly eager.

**Team Member Cost:** Due 30 days before your travel date

**\$650 per person**

This pays for food, lodging, utilities and transportation while in Haiti. Though Haiti is a very poor nation, many things there cost the equivalent or more than they do in the US. This also covers the short-term medical emergency insurance for the team member while on the trip. A portion of this goes to pay administrative costs, as the stateside office manager works to coordinate the details of the trip. A T-shirt is provided to every team member.

**Team Project Fees:** Due 30 days before your travel date

**Varies depending on Project  
Typically \$1500-\$3500/team**

This project fee pays for whatever project you are doing in Haiti. Mobile medical teams are the most expensive to facilitate. The project fee pays for a variety of necessities, including supplies and translators. The average Team Project Fee is \$2500.

### **Additional Expenses**

**Varies per person**

**Airfare:** Teams are required to arrange their own flight itineraries. Flight costs vary based on starting location and travel dates. Any baggage fees are the team members’ responsibility.

**Passport:** Team members obtaining or renewing a passport do so at their own expense.

**Immunizations:** Tetanus vaccinations and any other desired immunizations are paid for personally.

**Support Raising Expenses:** Printing, envelopes, stamps, etc.

**Travel Expenses:** Hotel costs if the teams stays overnight during the course of travel. Food or tips at the stateside airports. Fees for renting luggage carts in the US or Haitian airports. Carts in Haiti cost \$2US each

**Tourist Tax:** Foreigners entering Haiti are now required to pay a **\$10** tourist tax at the airport. Each team member should be prepared with the exact amount.

**Laundry & Pop:** Laundry service is available at the guesthouse for 25¢ per item. Locally made soda is available for purchase by team members.

**Souvenirs:** We certainly hope you take some reminders of the trip home with you, but team members are responsible for their own purchases! ☺

\*Team Fees are calculated based on a 7-day trip. Additional days will result in additional fees.
